The Lindenwood basketball teams will end their regular seasons this week with a pair of doubleheaders at Hyland Arena. The Lions will face Northwest Missouri on Thursday evening starting at 5:30 p.m., and they will have Senior Day versus Missouri Western on Saturday at 1:30 p.m.

Both teams have already clinched a spot in the MIAA Postseason Tournament, but they still have a lot to play for this week. The women's team looks to continue their improvement in the conference standings, and a pair of wins will give the squad its best conference record since 2013-14. The men's team has an opportunity for the biggest win in its NCAA history when it faces the defending national champions on Thursday night.
