The salaries are allowances for the agents at the United States Indian trading house having been particularly designated by a law of the last session of congress which took afoot on the first day of April last – I am no longer authorized to make you the annual allowance of \$25 for keeping up a stock of furniture – you will therefore audit in your first accounts with this department which you may send in after receipt of this any charges you have made for that purpose in accounts yours may have rendered for any time subsequent to that period –
