Leckie is the author of the Hugo-, Nebula-, Arthur C. Clarke-, and British Science Fiction Award-winning novel *Ancillary Justice* and its Locus Award-winning sequel *Ancillary Sword*. She

has also published many short stories, including "Hesperia and Glory," which was reprinted in *Science Fiction: The Best of the Year 2007* edited by Rich Horton. Roller Hockey Gold Captures Eighth Straight D3 National Title



The roller hockey Gold squad captured its eighth straight title with a 4-2 victory over Farmingdale State College Sunday afternoon at the National Collegiate Roller Hockey Association (NCRHA) D3 Championship at the Southwest Youth Ice Arena in Fargo, North Dakota.

The first half of the game belonged to the Rams, but the last half belonged to the Lions. Farmingdale scored in the opening period with an unassisted goal at 7:15. Lindenwood had a chance to tie the contest on a power play early in the second, but the Rams turned the tables and scored short-handed to take a 2-0 lead at 3:06. Lions fans had a right to be nervous at that point, but Lindenwood mounted a comeback from there, starting with an even strength tally from [Sam Koenig](#) midway through the period on a play set up by [Anthony Erace](#). The assist was a foreshadowing of bigger things to come for the Lions senior. Farmingdale took four penalties in the middle 20 minutes and Lindenwood capitalized on the last one when Spencer Marquiss split the pipes at 9:41 with help from [Chris Visico](#) and Koenig.
