Jill Hutcheson Wins Regional Kappa Delta Pi Counselor Award

According to a letter Hutcheson received notifying her of the honor, a panel of judges reviewed her nominations by regional chapter officers and determined that she is a leader who represents the mission and ideals of KDP and that she has achieved excellence in her role as a counselor.

In order to win this award, nominees must score higher than their peers in the areas of

modeling leadership, motivating and communicating with chapter members, impacting the careers of chapter officers and members, involvement in chapter programs and activities, and exemplifying the mission and ideals of the society.

Hutcheson will be featured on the society's main website, www.kdp.org, and will be formally recognized with a plaque at the society's convocation in Pittsburgh, Penn., on Oct. 26-28, 2017.
