On Wednesday, May 10, from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. on the front steps of Roemer Hall, there will be a rehearsal for Baccalaureate and Commencement. In case of rain, the rehearsal will be held in the Fellowship Hall of St. Charles Presbyterian Church.

On Friday, May 12, at 7:30 p.m., Baccalaureate will be held in the St. Charles Presbyterian Church. Afterwards, the Lindenwood Alumni Association will host a reception in the Fine Arts Building for seniors, their families and guests. All faculty and staff are invited to attend.

On Saturday, May 13, at 10:00 a.m. the annual Spring Commencement will be held in front of Sibley Hall. The Commencement Speaker will be announced later. A reception on the campus quadrangle will follow Commencement. In case of rain, Commencement will be in the St. Charles Presbyterian Church.

I also want to remind all employees that **Lindenwood will be open from 8:30 a.m. until noon on Saturday, May 13, and all offices are to remain open and staffed during this time.** There will be no compensatory time granted, and the administration appreciates the time given for this special once-a-year event.

All employees are requested to park in Lot H across from the Stadium on Commencement Day from which they will be shuttled to the Roemer Hall parking lot. Parking in faculty and staff lots, particularly adjacent to Roemer, are reserved for graduates, their families and guests attending Commencement.

Fulbright Scholar Program

The Council for International Exchange of Scholars is opening its 1990-1991 competition for overseas research and lecturing opportunities for American students. There are approximately 1000 Fulbright awards available each year for Americans to conduct research or to lecture at universities in more than 100 countries.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. United States Citizenship.
 2. For lecturing (in most cases): postdoctoral college or university teaching experience at the level and in the field of the lectureship sought.
 3. For research: a doctorate or comparable professional qualifications.
 4. In some cases, proficiency in a foreign language.
