Carnes Publishes Book

Geremy Carnes, Assistant Professor of English and the most recent recipient of Lindenwood's annual service award, has just published his first monograph. The book, titled <u>The Papist Represented Literature and the</u> <u>English Catholic Community, 1688–1791</u>, demonstrates that far from being marginalized or ignored, the 18th

Century English Catholic minority participated actively in the largely Protestant society and culture. In so doing, Carnes's book convincingly argues that, contrary to earlier literary histories of the period, eighteenth-century English literature is not a solely Protestant enterprise.
