Sir

I enclose your copy of a letter just received from Mr. Bowman. I have written him that he will hear from you by the Philad<sup>a</sup> mail at an early day which will determine him whether we should take the Boat on the stock for you or not. The only difference seems to be 18 feet in the length. If this addition is not very objectionable it will be better perhaps to take it than run the risk of delay. I have indeed send to him that he may follow your directions, as to the boat entirely. and that you will be soon with him. Let me hear from you ----- of mail.
