A visitation will be held from 9 to 11 a.m. on Saturday, Dec. 2, at West Side Baptist Church, 2677 Dunn Road in Florissant, Mo., followed immediately after by a life celebration. A meal will follow from 2 to 6 p.m. at DejaVu Café at 2805 Target Drive in St. Louis. Burial will

be at Lake Charles Cemetery, 7775 St. Charles Rock Road, 63114.

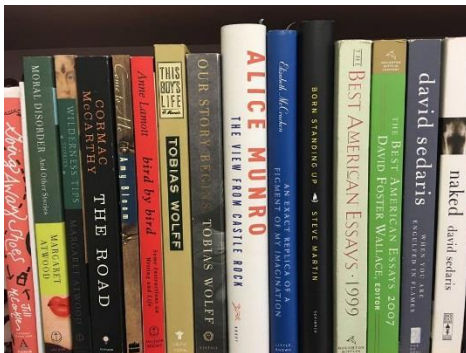
Student Research Conference-- Faculty Recommendations
