The first athletic event on the St. Charles campus for this school year will take place on Thursday night when the Lions football team opens up the 2016 season. Lindenwood will take on Central Oklahoma at 7 p.m. in Hunter Stadium.

The Lions have one of their most experienced teams since moving to the NCAA level, including 22 seniors and 16 returning starters. The top returner is preseason All-American Connor Harris, who is close to setting a NCAA record for career tackles.
