Baillio & Co. (I never owed them any other)
has been all paid, and fully discharged-
and my claim for \$1504.54 for advances on
the Mexican Road, has all been Settled and
paid- And We are now even; except that I
Still have a claim for 640 acres of Land
under the New Madrid Law.-
