

Brown-Hudson to be Published in Anthology

Heather Brown-Hudson, Ph.D., associate professor of French and gender studies, will be published in an anthology titled *The Absent Mother in the Cultural Imagination: Missing, Presumed Dead.* Brown-Hudson's chapter, titled "A Side of Family, Hold the Mother: Dare Wright and her Fictive Kin in the Lonely Doll Series," covers a missing or absent mother in a literature series.

The anthology is set to debut March 2017, to be published by Palgrave Macmillan. Brown-Hudson said her writing grew out of her doctoral dissertation. She got the news it would be published on Labor Day.

"I'm very excited to see my work published," Brown-Hudson said. "It was a year in the making, and it was great learning this Labor Day that my labor of love would be published."
