Soccer Games Highlight This Week's NCAA Athletics Home Events

The Lindenwood soccer teams will both be home twice this week, which highlights this week's NCAA athletics home schedule.

The women's soccer team is off to its best start since 2011 and will look to continue it with two non-conference matches this week. The Lady Lions host Central Missouri on Friday evening at 7 p.m., followed by a 1 p.m. Sunday contest against Missouri Western. The Jennies are also undefeated and ranked No. 4 in the country, while Missouri Western is off to a 3-1 start this season.

The men's soccer team will be home on Thursday night and Saturday afternoon. On Thursday at 8:30 p.m., the Lions take on Southern Nazarene. Saturday at 2:30 p.m., Lindenwood will be facing off against Ouachita Baptist. Lindenwood games have all gone down to the wire this season, with every contest being decided by one goal or ending in a tie. All four soccer games will be at Hunter Stadium, and admission is free for Lindenwood faculty and staff.

Over at the Lindenwood Tennis Courts, the men's and women's tennis teams will open its fall dual schedule on Thursday afternoon. The Lions and Lady Lions will both take on Missouri Baptist at 2 p.m.


