## Dr. Thomas Trice Selected as Employee of the Month for September (BV)

Assistant Professor of Criminal Justice, Dr. Thomas Trice has been named Lindenwood Belleville Employee of the Month for September.

degree program for one of the most popular majors on campus: criminal justice. "My primary duty is to educate our students and provide them with knowledge that empowers them and builds on their self-efficacy," he said. In addition, Trice advises several student clubs, mentors some of the athletic teams, and pursues his own scholarly research.

Beyond the classroom, he has established a monthly critical thinking award for outstanding criminal justice majors, and he created and analyzed the results of an assessment survey for the Division of Social and Behavioral Sciences. Trice is a member of the Lindenwood Belleville faculty and staff running team and has participated in several campus events to benefit others, such as donating books to the Psychology Club Book Sale and collecting clean water for the residents of Flint, Mich.

He was nominated for Employee of the Month by Dr. Diana Jacobs, professor of psychology. "When Dr. Trice started at Lindenwood Belleville only one year ago as a first-time, full-time faculty member, he hit the ground running," she said. "It wasn't long before students started flocking to his office. He clearly has their attention, and they clearly respect and want a relationship with him. I've worked at LU-Belleville for five years now and have never felt so compelled to nominate a colleague for this honor as I have for Dr. Trice. Although I'm the colleague who has been in the profession a long time, it is Dr. Trice who teaches me new lessons and serves, in many instances, as my role model."

"I am tremendously honored for the award and humbled by it," said Trice. "A very special thank you to my colleague for taking the time to nominate me."

## Lindenwood English Professor Published (STC)

On Oct. 13, Crossing the Divide: From the Poets of St. Louis, published by Vagabond Press in Venice, California, was released, with two poems by Lindenwood Associate Professor of English Alex Balogh, "Election Day" and "Peruanita" included.

The focus of the book is the quest for unity, diversity, and community in Saint Louis, especially following the events in Ferguson which helped trigger a nationwide debate on racial and economic inequalities. The forward was written by Juan Felipe Herrera, the current poet laureate of the United States, and the poems were chosen by current Saint Louis poet laureate (and Lindenwood professor emeritus) Michael Castro.
