Early Enrollment for Honors Students

If you have an active honors student that has lost early enrollment privileges (but still has the requisite GPA of 3.3 or above), it is because the early enrollment policy has changed. In an effort to reduce the number of students enrolling early, we are requiring junior status students to have completed at least 4 honors courses, and senior status students to have completed 6. The 'EE' on the portal means that they DO have early enrollment privileges. The loss of these privileges does NOT correspond to any other change in their status as active honors students, and the may continue to pursue university honors.
