Faculty Polish Up on Distance Learning at Boot Camp



More than 55 Lindenwood University faculty members participated in the inaugural Best-Practice Boot Camp for Distance Education on Jan. 4-5. Over two intense days of training, participants explored evidence-based practices for designing and delivering online and hybrid courses.

The BPB, held in the Spellmann Center's Anheuser-Busch Leadership Room, covered topics such as managing online courses and switching traditional classes to online or hybrid courses. The design and delivery of the BPB is a collaborative effort among the offices of Academic Affairs, Lindenwood Online, and Academic Technology Services.

"The interest and turnout for the Boot Camp clearly demonstrates faculty commitment to continuous professional improvement," said Dr. Joseph Alsobrook, interim director of Lindenwood Online. "It's exciting so see the power of strategic collaboration in action."

Alsobrook also said more training events are planned for the future.
