I have this day Sold to George C. Sibley for the price of One Hundred & Thirty Dollars (the Receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge) a Spotted Roan Gelding, aged five years in May last, full Sixteen Hands high, of the Blood of the Wild Barbs of the plains of Louisiana
