We the Subscribers hereby engage & bind ourselves unto Geo: C. Sibley to labor faithfully and diligently as carsmen on board of his Boat from this place to S^t.

Louis in Terry of Louisiana to perform all the duties, that good Boatmen are accustomed to perform, & to continue with him until discharged— It being left optional with the Said Sibley to discharge either or any of us or not at any time or place (between here and S^t. Louis) that he may think proper, he Settling fairly & justly with us— It is understood that we only engage ourselves to go to S^t. Louis.
