Lindenwood Undergraduate Tuition will Increase Just 2.3 Percent

St. Charles, Mo.— Room, board, and tuition for traditional undergraduate resident students at Lindenwood University will increase just 2.3 percent in the fall of 2009 to \$20,360 per year.

Lindenwood's Board of Directors approved the increase on Friday.

Undergraduate students in Lindenwood's adult accelerated program will see a 3.3 percent increase. The cost of a nine-hour cluster of courses will now be \$2,790 per quarter. Graduate students in the adult accelerated program will see a 2.8 percent increase to \$3,330 per nine-hour cluster.

Lindenwood University, founded in 1827, is an independent liberal arts university offering 84 undergraduate degree programs and 37 graduate programs in diverse areas of study in traditional and accelerated formats. Lindenwood operates a residential campus in historic St. Charles, as well as 10 extended sites throughout the St. Louis metropolitan area.
