PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION.

Fort Osage, Oct. 11, 1824.

MR. PATTEN,

HAVING seen in your paper of the 25th ult. a notice of certain proceedings of the friends of Mr. Clay, at a public meeting in Franklin, at which it was recommended to support Judge Todd as Elector for the 1st Electoral District, I hereby declare my hearty concurrence in those proceedings, and that I will cordially cooperate in carrying them into effect. Having no other wish on this subject, than to secure the vote of the District for Mr. Clay, and believing that the course recommended by the meeting alluded to, will most effectually secure that object, I am no longer a candidate.
