Women's Lacrosse Goes for Conference Championship on Friday While Men's Lacrosse Has Senior Day




The Lindenwood women's lacrosse team will go for a sixth straight conference championship on Friday afternoon at Hunter Stadium when the Lady Lions face Regis at 1 p.m. The Lady Lions, who are ranked No. 1 in one national poll, are 17-0 on the season and have not lost a conference game since moving to the

NCAA level. Regis is ranked in the top-15 nationally, and will come to St. Charles with a 14-1 record. Come cheer on Lindenwood in a battle of two of the top teams in NCAA Division II.
