Army Apache Helicopter to Land in Lindenwood Stadium

St. Charles, Mo. – The Lindenwood University Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) is sponsoring the display of an AH-64 Apache Attack Helicopter inside the school's Harlen C. Hunter Stadium on Wednesday, April 22. The helicopter will land on the athletic field at 10 a.m. and depart at 3 p.m.

First Lieutenant Adrienne Moore, senior ROTC instructor and the first female in the history of the Missouri National Guard to fly an Apache helicopter, will pilot the aircraft. She and a former Apache combat pilot will be on-hand to discuss the aircraft and the ROTC program with students and visitors.
