I wrote you yesterday, and enclosed
you an order for the wife's Lammey's. in addition
to the few little articles then directed to be purcha-
sed. I enclose annex a list of such things as
you may go on to purchase immediately & the
sooner the better - for any thing amounting to
more than \$100. or thereay. draw on me at
right. and your Bills shall be paid, forwarding
Bill parcels at each time to show the amt. regu-
larly by post. that I may have the advices respec-
tively as the Bills appear - where I have not
mentioned the price, I expect the article to be
bought at the terms expressed accompanying
your letter of the 12th. as far as designated by
you. and where this is not the case you must
get on the best terms you can, I wish you to
purchase those marked thus X first as they

on the greatest object, should however any
of the sellers increase in price until it be but
a trifle let the purchase of such articles alone
until they come to their issues or we try else-
where, yet I wish you to secure as early after
the receipt of this as you can the articles marked +
unless they attempt an increase in price
anything that is an object. I hope whenever
the amount is an object of any one person you
will be able to get a draft for the cash to pay
at the bottom of the bill. Should there
be any difficulties you passing drafts on
me at sight you will as I before stated
leave the goods till paid. or get Mr Cooke
to do me the favor to go with you to an-
swer for you in which case I am sure he will
readily do on showing him this letter. I
shall send you the £100 you ask on your
account on Monday & 2 or 300 in cash to
assist you in these purchases. I have not
yet completed the list of purchases to be
made by you but nearly so. advise me
regularly every Post what you are doing.
