I wrote you by yesterday's
mail and emitted you four hundred Dollars
I now annex a list of such articles as I want at
this time, to compleat the orders on hand, and

heretofore sent, but some of them included, &

You will go on then to close your purchases

as fast as you can, and you will please inform me
in the course of a day or two, if any and what
particular articles are not to be had in Balte, that
I may see as speedily as possible see about getting them
elsewhere. I have limited my prices in this list as
I am persuaded that by this time you have made
yourself well acquainted with prices, and I am
satisfied you will take to obtain every thing on
the best terms
