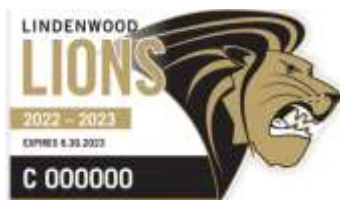

Adjunct Conference 2022

The Adjunct Conference hosted by Academic Affairs and the Learning Academy staff will be held on Saturday, August 13. This event is designed to recognize the crucial contributions of our university's adjunct instructors and connect instructors to helpful campus resources that will support their teaching. The format of the event will be hybrid, allowing adjunct instructors to attend in person or virtually.

At the Adjunct Conference, attendees will take care of practical matters like ID cards and parking passes, as well as gather information from helpful departments across campus, such as SASS, the Writing Center, and academic services.
