Employees and their Families Needed for Research Study

Researchers in the Exercise and Performance Nutrition Laboratory at Lindenwood are recruiting healthy men and women ages 30 - 60 to complete a four-week research study that examines the impact of a dietary supplement on cognitive function, well-being, and mood. The study protocol requires four separate 60 minute laboratory visits in which participants will have their blood drawn and will complete several electronic questionnaires and cognitive tasks. There is no cost for participating and cash compensation will be provided. Participants must follow a prescribed pattern of supplementation and study visits, and regularly communicate with the research staff to maintain eligibility in the study.

RISE-Certified Instructor Program: Application Open Now!

The RISE-Certified Instructor Program is for adjunct instructors at Lindenwood University, and supports instructors' development in the RISE Project pillars: Rigor, Inclusiveness, Support, and Engagement.

The program can be completed asynchronously, and will involve five online training modules, mentorship cohorts, a teaching consultation, and an additional training related to the RISE framework. Participants will also be asked to complete a survey at the start of the program and at its completion.

Twenty instructors will be selected for the program (five from each College). Participants who successfully complete the program will receive \$500 compensation for their work. This is a great opportunity to enhance your teaching using the RISE pillars and connect with other faculty at Lindenwood.
