Sir

The annexed is a list of sales made here in April last of the Statters Furs and a few other articles collected by you last season they were all brought here by the way of the Ohio and Potomac (except the Indian dressed Deer skins which came by the way of Orleans) at the expence from St Louis of about 8 cents per lb and came in remarkable good order. The sales were very satisfactory except the Indian dressed Deer skins which I do not answer and I fear never will -
