Enrollment Management, Academic Affairs, Office of Strategic Information, Fiscal Affairs, and Information Technology teams have worked diligently to build and configure Anthology Student, our new Student Information System (SIS). The project team continues to invest significant effort into building the system and the project is on track to launch on November 28. Progress updates will come out weekly in the LUDigest. Lindenwood specific training for Anthology Student will be developed by department area Subject Matter Experts. The training is expected to be delivered in October and November. Subject Matter Experts have already begun developing training plans and supplemental resources.
