Having been obliged in several instances to send into the treasury letters from the factors as vouchers to explain errors which had been found by them on opening goods forwarded from this office I have to request that in future when errors occur that you make out & forward to me duplicate statements shewing the date of the Invoice & the numbers of the packages in which such errors are found -

No credit will be given on the Books of this office for damage which the goods may sustain on their way to the factories, but in such cases I wish to be informed by letter as heretofore, as it may enable me to prevent in some degree future occurrences of that nature.

To enable me to obtain credit on the Books of the treasury for the goods forwarded from this office to the factories, it is absolutely necessary that the factors should forward to me two copies of my Invoices receipted by them - This has been done in very few instances since I have been in office; I must therefore request that you will ~~make~~ do this as soon as practicable for the supplies which you have rec^d from me or from other agents by my directions & that you will not neglect to do it for any supplies you may receive in future - I am &c
