Sir

Inclosed you have an Invoice of 4
Boxes Rifles lodged at Pittsburg to be shipped on board
the Boat as she passes from Brownsville with the goods
forwarded from this office on the 23 ult: for your factory
amount \$519.50.

There are 50 Casks Powder each 50 lbs lodged at
Shipping port Kentucky which will be shipped on
board said Boat for your factory as she passes that
place - I cannot at present send you an Invoice of the
Powder not having received an exact account of its cost
for your government in fixing a selling price (in case an
Invoice does not reach you in time) it cost about \$22. ps Neg
