Sir,

Geo. Town Oct. 12<sup>th</sup> 1812.

The secretary of War has directed that the Annuity for the Osage Indian shall be supplied for the year from your Factory - You will therefore deliver on Genl. Clark's application or to his order in value at cost, as shown by the invoice sent from this Office, and in such article as he may require - Goods to the Great Osage to amount of \$1,000, and to the Little Osage Tribe to amount of 500\$ - You will make distinct invoice for each by duplicate and get them signed by Genl. Clark and forward them to this office -

You will be careful to make up the annuity of good merchandise and such as will give satisfaction to the Indian - at the same time so far as Genl. Clark may find it right to yield to such a selection, to make it with as little injury to your apartment for Trade as can be done
