CAH Receives Bodyswaps and Meta's Immersive Power Skills Education Grant

The College of Arts and Humanities has received the Bodyswaps & Meta's Education Grant, which provides institutional access to all services on the power skills development [platform](#) until May 2023, and 10 additional Quest 2 VR headsets for the XR and Gaming Lab.

The training platform offers immersive experiences to practice power skills, and while most effective in VR, it also can be used on desktop PC and mobile devices.

This platform provides a safe space for learners to practice demonstrating empathy, public speaking, interviewing, DEI, and other employability skills without judgement. Learners are then given the opportunity to experience how they came across from another person's perspective and receive personalized feedback on their responses.
