This morning when I collected the mules to start them for Ft. Osage I find that the boys had let one of them get away Which I __ sending& one more of the public mules has not been seen for some weeks. As soon as I can get hold of them I will dispose of all those that remain on hand. I omitted mentioning in any of my letters of yesterday yjay I furnished the boys with \$28 to defray their expenses up to your residence which A. Carson will account to you for & hand over the ballance to you of any.
