Requirement changes in the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA) have resulted in the following changes effective Friday, June 9:

- New security awareness training will be provided in Skillsoft.
- Encryption of all Lindenwood assigned computers.
- Encryption of all confidential and restricted data when emailed.
- All students, faculty, and staff will now be required to use MFA when on campus.

New Cybersecurity Trainings on Skillsoft

As a requirement of the Federal Trade Commission's Safeguards Rule and the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA), Lindenwood University is committed to providing its employees with up-to-date security awareness training. In line with the updated GLBA Safeguards rules (16 CFR 314.4(e)(1)), we must ensure Lindenwood employees receive training that reflects the risks identified by our risk assessment. To comply with these regulations and Title IV rules, we are providing two security awareness courses via Skillsoft/Percipio (Compliance Short: Cyber Security & Compliance Short: Cyber Security 3), which are required to be completed by Friday, August 18. We anticipate both courses will take an average of 15 minutes to complete. Be on the lookout for an email from Skillsoft/Percipio detailing the new trainings and how to access them.
