Officer Rachel Clementz Memorial Bracelets

The department of Public Safety and Security is partnering with the [National Alliance on Mental Illness](#) to increase awareness of mental health resources and support services. NAMI provides advocacy, education, support, and awareness to individuals and families affected by mental illness. The timing of this partnership comes in the wake of a heartbreaking event that has impacted the Lindenwood University community. On June 6, Officer Rachel Clementz lost her long battle against mental health. In honor of Officer Clementz's life, the department of Public Safety has organized a campaign to sponsor memorial wristbands. All proceeds will go toward [Crisis Intervention Training](#) for first responders. CIT training provides first responders with tools for responding to mental health crises in their communities. Additionally, CIT training provides mental health resources specifically for officers so they can process their experiences as first responders. Wristbands are now available for a minimum donation of \$5 each (cash only). To support this initiative, please stop by the Department of Public Safety and Security office located in the First Capitol Suite (Suite A), Monday–Friday between 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. while supplies last.
