New Cyber Security Trainings Due August 18

As a requirement of the Federal Trade Commission's Safeguards Rule and the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA), Lindenwood University is committed to providing our employees with up-to-date security awareness training. In line with the updated GLBA Safeguards rules (16 CFR 314.4(e)(1)), we must ensure that our employees receive training that reflects the risks identified by our risk assessment. To comply with these regulations and Title IV rules, we are providing two security awareness courses via Skillsoft/Percipio (Compliance Short: Cyber Security and Compliance Short: Cyber Security 3), which are required to be **completed by Friday, August 18**.
