## **Lindenwood Undergraduate Tuition and Fees will Increase 2.2 Percent**

St. Charles, Mo.—Room, board, tuition and fees for traditional undergraduate resident students at Lindenwood University will increase 2.2 percent in the fall of 2010 to \$20,810 per year from their 2009 level of \$20,260 per year.

Lindenwood's Board of Directors approved the increase at their November meeting. Lindenwood President James D. Evans said the increase is necessary because of rising costs of operation and stressed that the school works hard to keep increases at a minimum.

Undergraduate students in Lindenwood's adult accelerated program will see a 2.3 percent increase. The cost of a nine-hour cluster of courses will now be \$2,853 per quarter. Graduate students in the adult accelerated program will see a 2.7 percent increase to \$3,420 per nine-hour cluster.

Lindenwood University, founded in 1827, is an independent liberal arts university offering 84 undergraduate degree programs and 37 graduate programs in diverse areas of study in traditional and accelerated formats. Lindenwood operates a residential campus in historic St. Charles, as well as 10 extension sites throughout the St. Louis metropolitan area.
