Sir

I have before me your several communications of the 28th & 29th ultimo, notifying me of your having values on me at sight for five hundred dollars, to defray the contingent expenses of transporting your funds & letters by the goods from St. Louis: - The bill shall be honored, when presented - also enclosing Benben Lewis' receipt a duplicate for nine buffides, to replace those returned to you in my letter of the 24th March - Under cover of another letter dated 13th ultimo, I have received the duplicates of six vouchers for \$356⁰⁰ - for money expended on Contingent account in the quarter ending in March last; and copies of two invoices received by you.
