Sir

Enclosed you will receive Invoice of Merchandise forwarded from this Office on the 27th ultimo for your Factory amount \$1020⁰⁰/₆₁ - & also Invoice of several parcels Wampum forwarded per post via St. Louis amt^d \$157⁰⁰/₈₇. Major Woolley has been requested to forward these Goods to St. Louis immediately on the opening of the River. I hope they will reach St. Louis by the 1st of April. We shall not I fear be able to obtain any thing like the quantity of Wampum we need for the present year, even at 5^{cts}/₁₀₀ for Blue & 3^{cts}/₁₀₀ for White of 1000⁰⁰ -
