You will please on receipt
of this with as little delay as possible, to furnish the
annuities due to the Great & Little Osage tribes of
Indians up to and including the present year, in
such articles of merchandise as are usually distri-
-buted

puted to them and at their cost prices. You will be carefull to use the usual forms of Invoices, receipts &c and on their being prepared you will forward them to this office. The amount now due those tribes is as follows. —

Great Osages on the accounts for 1817:18 + 19	\$2000.
" " " Osage ————— 1820	500.
Little Osages ————— 1820	500.
	<u>\$3000.</u>

Add to your Invoices as usual fifteen per cent for transportation.
