Did you know that Louis LaBeaume, the architect for Ayres, Butler, Nicolls, Roemer, Irwin, Butler Library, the Memorial Arts Building, and Warner Hall, played a significant role in designing many of the buildings for the 1904 St. Louis World's Fair? Among some of LaBeaume's other designs were the Kiel Auditorium and Opera House, several Art Deco buildings in downtown St. Louis, St. Luke's Hospital, and many homes found in the Central West End.
