Academic Policy Update for 2024-25

The University Curriculum Committee is pleased to share the following academic policy updates for the 2024-25 year. These updates can be found in the academic catalogs and [Policy Library](#).

- There are two new policies providing guidance for Course Enrollment Limits and Student Bereavement Leave.
- Several changes to policies for graduate students include changes to the Policy on Additional Graduate Degrees which provides a pathway for using credits earned for graduate certificates toward a full graduate degree, revises the Policy on Extra Credit graduate students, and provides guidance on the process for changing your degree path/major as a graduate student.
- The Policy on Earning Credit for Prior Learning includes a Seal of Biliteracy option.
- And finally, the Policy for Non-Degree Seeking Students increases the number of allowed credits from 12 – 15.
