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

High School Athletes Needed for Research Studies

The Exercise and Performance Nutrition Lab seeks high school athletes to participate in two studies. Both studies provide valuable insights into body composition and performance, and they're a great way for young adults to contribute to important research. If your child is interested, please [reach out](#) for more information

Study 1: Creatine Supplementation on Body Composition and Performance

This 8-week study explores how creatine affects body composition and athletic performance. Participants will take either creatine or a placebo daily and visit our lab three times for about 2 hours each. They'll undergo body composition assessments, strength tests, and a quick blood draw to ensure well-being. Upon completion, participants will receive a \$25 gift card, a t-shirt, and a shaker bottle.

Study 2: Fueling Needs and Health Status Assessment

This 1-2 week study involves two visits (30 minutes and 1.5 hours). Participants will undergo body composition assessments, lower body strength and power tests, a VO₂max test, and track their diet and activity with an activity tracker for 5 days. Participants will receive a t-shirt upon completion.
