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## 'A Christmas Carol' Returns to Lindenwood Stage for Holidays

The Lindenwood University Department of Theatre will continue its 2010-11 season with the perennial holiday favorite "A Christmas Carol"; performances will be at 7:30 p. m. on Nov. 18-20 and Dec. 2-4.

This year's production is directed by Emily Jones, of the Lindenwood theatre faculty with a cast of more than 30 people headed by Jimmy Krawczyk as Ebenezer Scrooge, Joshua Nash Payne as Bob Cratchit, Cassie Ballard as the Ghost of Christmas Past, Ryan Wood as the Ghost of Christmas Present, and Trevor Potthoff as Tiny Tim Cratchit.

Stage manager is Jennette Kleewien. Scenic design is by Donnell Walsh. Lighting design is by Keith Barinowski with sound design and engineering by Drew Matney. Costume design is by Donna Northcott. Technical direction is by Tim Poertner with choreography by Janet Strzelec and music advising by Pamela Grooms.
