To Peter Hagner Esq. 3rd Auditor Treas. Dept. Washington City.

Sir:

I enclose you herein the receipt of Edward Davis for \$97.34 him for services to the United States under the Commission to mark out a Road to N. Mexico in I825---This receipt assertains to the disbursements account heretofore remitted to your office) of the commission above named and is furnished to supply the place of others of the same import that accompanied the account but which have been lost since their arrival at Washington as appears from your letter of the 20th April last. The absence of Col. Reeves from home and other causes have prevented the forwarding of this voucher sooner-I will thank you to acknowledge its receipt. The other parts of your communication of 20th April last will be attended to as soon as I can have intercourse with my late colleagues, who have both been absent from home one of them not even yet returned.
