## Temple Grandin LU Speech to be Rebroadcast on LUTV

March 14, 2012

Renowned author and autism advocate Temple Grandin's popular March 13 speech at Lindenwood University will be rebroadcast on LUTV for Charter and U-Verse customers and on the Web at 7 p.m. on March 15, 16, 19, 22, 23, and 26. The broadcast will be enhanced with slides from her presentation.

The speech drew capacity crowds not only to the 1,200-seat Bezemes Family Theater, but also to live video feeds at several overflow areas on campus with more than 1,000 additional seats, making it the best-attended event by far in the history of the Lindenwood University Speaker Series.

The 2011-12 Lindenwood University Speaker Series will conclude Tuesday, April 10, with a 7 p.m. presentation by actor and author Hill Harper.
