The Lindenwood University School of Business and Entrepreneurship will present a roundtable discussion of public policy titled "Unexpected Growth in Uncertain Economic Times: Sustaining Entrepreneurial Success through Flexibility and Change" at 3 p.m. on Wednesday, April 4. The free event will take place in Harmon Hall's Dunseth Auditorium on the St. Charles campus, located at 209 S. Kingshighway, St. Charles, Mo., 63301.

Howard Wall, director of Lindenwood's Institute for the Study of Economics and the Environment, will lead the discussion. Other roundtable participants will include corporate leaders Linda Haberstroh of Phoenix Textile Corporation, Nancy McConnell of Stone Soup Cottage, Doug Mueller of Mueller Prost PC, and Randy Schilling of Candlestiq.

Haberstroh founded Phoenix in 1983 and has since led the company to become one of the nation's leading providers of textile products and services for nursing homes and hospitals. McConnell's restaurant in Cottleville, Mo., was voted St. Louis Restaurant of the Year in 2010 by St. Louis Magazine. Mueller leads a team of St. Louis certified public accountants and business advisors, and is a nationally recognized consultant for the Wall Street Journal and Money Magazine. Schilling founded the information technology consulting firm Quilogy and is currently building a new computing company based on the production of a cloud service platform.
