Students, City to Launch New Bus Routes

March 21, 2012

The Lindenwood University Student Government Association will host a ribbon-cutting ceremony for school's new St. Charles Area Transit System (SCAT) bus route stop at 1:40 p.m. on Monday, April 2. The event will take place at the J. Scheidegger Center for the Arts, located at 2300 West Clay Street in St. Charles, Mo., 63301.

SCAT consists of several bus routes that provide transportation to various locations within the City of St. Charles, as well as to the MetroLink North Hanley transit station in St. Louis. Curb-to-curb service is provided for all riders, and all busses are equipped with wheelchair lifts.

"Lindenwood previously had a SCAT stop at the Auto Zone on the edge of the campus, but students weren't all that informed on where it was and it wasn't being used much," said LSGA senator Paul Baker. "With the help of the City of St. Charles, we hope to make this new stop at the J. Scheidegger Center more convenient and open up this mode of transportation to Lindenwood's student body, especially to those who don't have vehicles."

The SCAT fare for adults is 50 cents per ride. A 20-punch pass card is also available through the city's Public Works Department. For more information, visit www.stcharlescitymo.gov.
