

ST. CHARLES MAYORAL DEBATE SET FOR MARCH 11 IN YOUNG HALL

March 6, 2015

For the second consecutive St. Charles mayoral election, Lindenwood University will co-host with the Greater St. Charles County Chamber of Commerce a debate between St. Charles' mayoral candidates in the upcoming April 7 municipal election.

Incumbent Mayor Sally Faith and County Councilman Mike Klinghammer will debate at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, March 11, in Young Hall Auditorium on Lindenwood's St. Charles campus. The event is free and open to the public. Seating is on a first-come, first-served basis.



Professor Joe Cernik, chair of the Political Science Department, will moderate the debate, which will be televised live on LUTV-HD, Lindenwood's cable television channel and will be available for viewing online afterwards. LUTV is at channel 989 on Charter digital, channel 99 on AT&T U-Verse, and frequency 106 using a QAM tuner on a digital television. Online, LUTV is available at www.lindenwood.edu/lutv/.

Each candidate will have three minutes each for opening and closing statements. The candidates will also respond to questions provided by the chamber. Members of the general public may also submit questions for consideration via the Chamber's Facebook page or via Twitter using the hashtag #stcmayordebate.

"This is the second time Lindenwood will host the St. Charles mayoral debate," said Cernik. "As with the first debate, an important city event will be aided by the university's facilities and TV station to bring this event to the Saint Charles community."
