### RAMS EXECUTIVES TO HEADLINE PANEL DISCUSSION

March 11, 2015

The Lindenwood University Sport Management Department will host a panel discussion with St. Louis Rams Executives Kevin Demoff and Artis Twyman next Tuesday, March 17. The forum will be held at 5:30 p.m. in Dunseth Auditorium in Harmon Hall on the Lindenwood campus.

Demoff is the Rams' chief operating officer and executive vice president of football operations. He recently completed his sixth season with the St. Louis Rams, and he has worked in the NFL for 10 years. In his current capacity, he serves as a liaison to ownership on all operational matters. Demoff oversees the Rams' entire business operations and works with General Manager Les Snead and Head Coach Jeff Fisher in aspects of the team's football operations.

Twyman recently completed his third year as the senior director of communications for the Rams. He has been with the Rams for 12 years and has worked in the NFL for 15 seasons. In his current role, he oversees the media relations staff and directs the Rams' communication efforts.

The St. Louis Rams have been one of the most talked about teams in the National Football League (NFL) this offseason, with issues ranging from relocation to the trading of former first overall draft pick Sam Bradford. Demoff and Twyman will discuss these items and others, as well as provide students with information about their backgrounds and careers. There will also be an open forum in which students can ask questions to Demoff and Twyman.
