## NONPROFIT PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SERIES HOSTS FINAL SPEAKER ON APRIL 15

April 1, 2015

Lindenwood University's 2014-2015 Nonprofit Professional Development Series will host its sixth and final speaker of the spring semester from 3:30 to 5 p.m. on April 15 in the Memorial Arts Building on the St. Charles campus. The topic is "From Ratchet to Resilient: Nonprofit Bootcamp 101?"

During the workshop, in Latzer Hall, Dr. Patrick Walker will outline hard choices nonprofit managers, leaders, and social entrepreneurs must consider as they navigate through governance, conflicts of interest, and corporate legal liability. This seminar is intended for nonprofit executive directors, senior directors, board members, and all businesses who work closely with nonprofit organizations whose goal is to improve and enhance society-at-large.



Walker is an award-winning professor and lawyer with more than 19 years of expertise in educational and organizational leadership, corporate diversity and inclusion, corporate governance, compliance, management, and assessment. Walker's teaching experience at Lindenwood as a nonprofit administration faculty member includes courses in management, law, strategy, leadership, ethics, and small business consulting. Published in management journals, law journals, and conference proceedings, Walker's research explores interdisciplinary approaches to social entrepreneurship in addition to small business and nonprofit "matchmaking."

Lindenwood's St. Charles campus is located at 209 S. Kingshighway. The cost to attend is \$15 per individual in advance or \$25 at the door if space permits.
